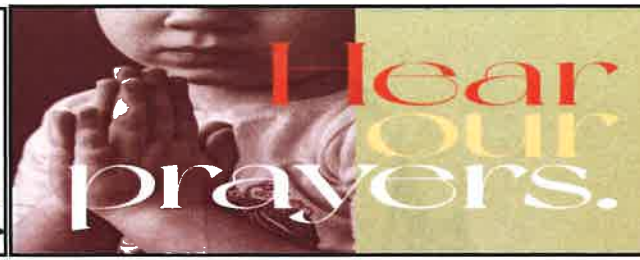
The celebration of Christmas is a time of renewal and hope. It is a time for families and friends to join in the goodness of God, and His divine purpose.

In every age, O God, you have called us to be your people, to be your Church.

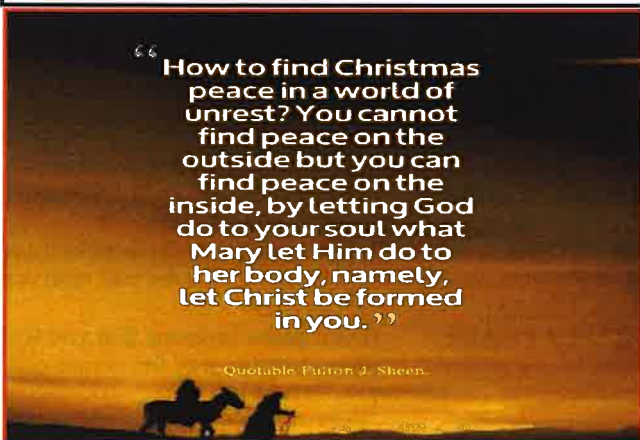
In this time, we begin anew to discern the pathways that will lead us, your people, closer to you.
