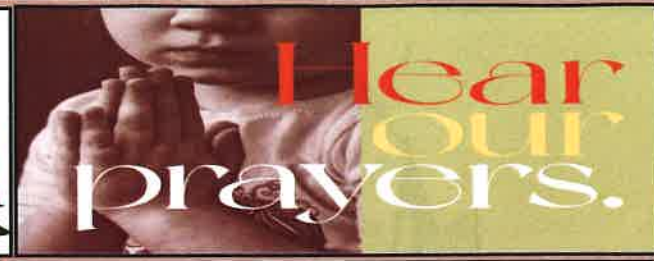
**ROAD TO RENEWAL
