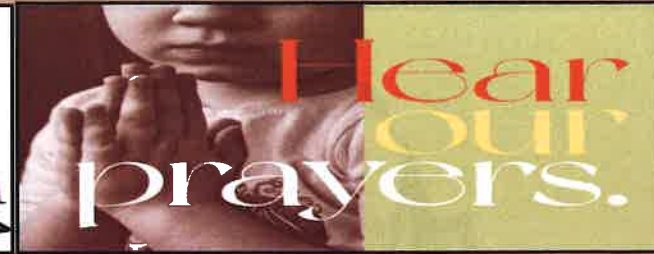
**ROAD TO RENEWAL

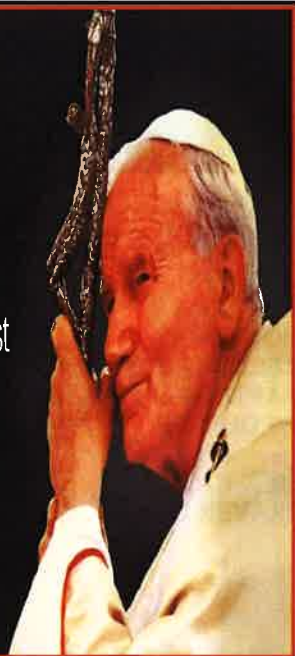
