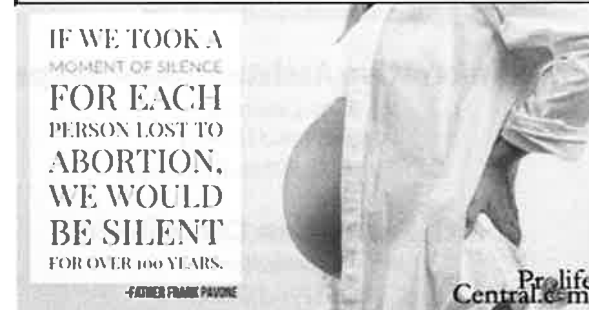
Attention all Altar Servers!!

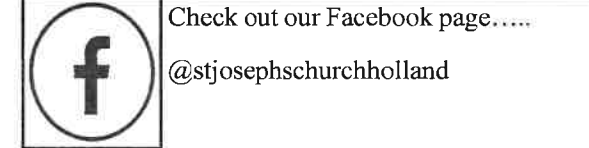
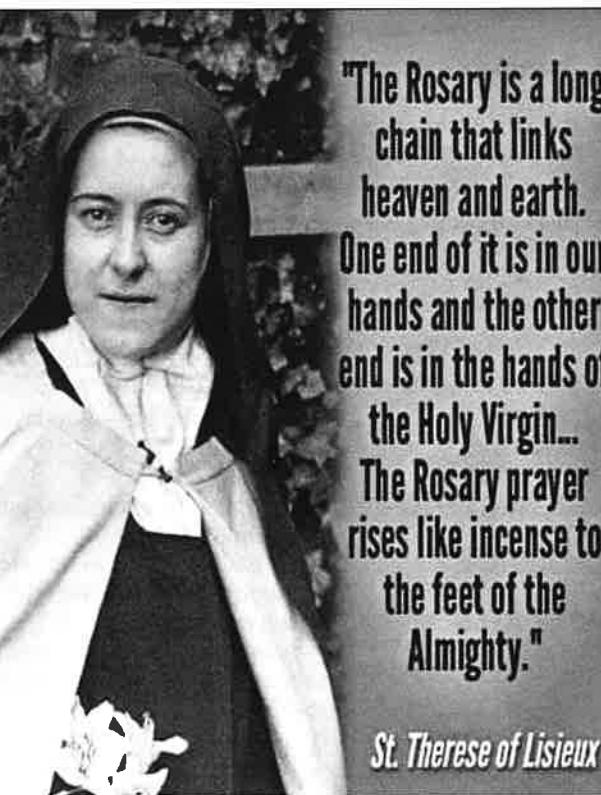
