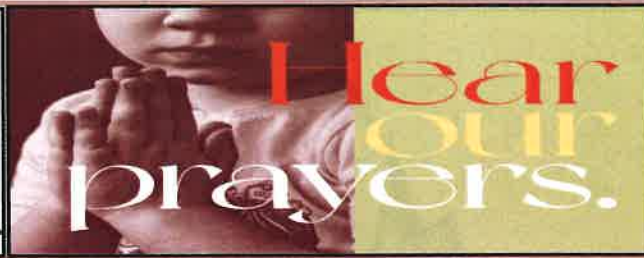
St Joseph's Parish will be participating in a
