The Disciple Maker Index Survey is Open! Please Read and Help!

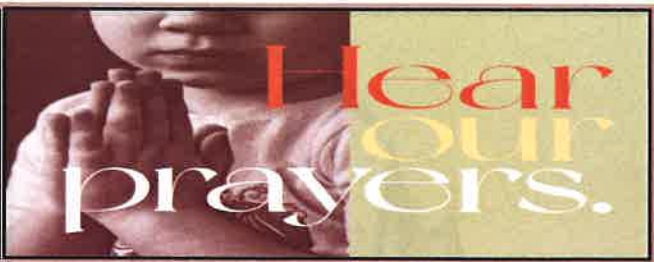
It's official! The Disciple Maker Index Survey is open and we need your help!

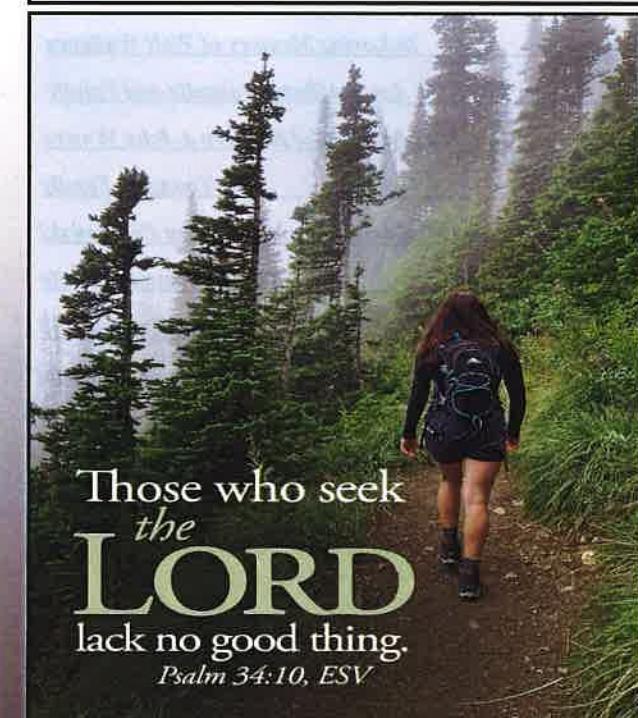


The annual Appeal in support of Catholic Charities of Buffalo and the Fund for the Faith is again underway. Please consider giving to this most worthy charity.
