
FAMILY NEWS & EVENTS

Our Gospel reading today relates to how people tried to trip Jesus up by asking him if paying taxes to Rome is legal. His response of. 'Give to Caesar what is Caesar's. and to God what s God's." is a stark reminder that we are a part of two worlds while we live on this earth. We have both civil and moral responsibilities. Fortunately, we live in a nation where civil law usually coincides with moral law. However, the union is not perfect: when life begins, is euthanasia proper, etc. When faced with a conflict it is important to remain faithful to the Law of God as revealed through Jesus Note that Jesus specifically steered his disciples away from any form of retribution. Instead, he directed them to continue to move on to a place where their message will be received. The specific situations we find ourselves in today differ from the culture Jesus lived in. However, the basic principles Jesus taught us through word and action still must continue to be respected throughout our lives.


